## School Swimming Program

We have been able to organise a swimming program early next term, for all classes, to be held at the Barr Reserve. However this will be dependent on return to school and what restrictions are in place.

If everything goes ahead as planned, the Junior unit classes will be swimming each Wednesday for five weeks, the 3/4 classes each Tuesday and Friday for the first three weeks, and the senior classes will begin week 2, each Monday and Thursday, for three weeks. A note will be sent home to each of the older classes with more specific information, when the 3-6 students return to school next term

The cost of the program is only **\$8.00 per student**, as we have some swimming grant money that has been allocated to the program. This will cover the cost of each lesson as well as bus transportation.

\*\*Please do not send this money to school until we confirm that the program will go ahead. A number of families do have money that can be allocated to the program,. We will inform each family of any cost that may be required.
