# 3/4 HAPPENINGS












The 3/4 team opened their cardboard arcade today

## Kids' sports programs can cost a lot, and not everyone can afford it. The good news is round 2 of the Get Active Kids Voucher Program is now open.

Do your children love sport and getting active? Does your family have a Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card? You may be eligible for up to \$200 to put towards the cost of your child's participation in sport and active recreation activities.

In Round 2, applicants can claim eligible expenses incurred between 1 January 2021 and 9 July 2021. Applications close 5pm, Friday 9 July 2021. Special consideration also applies for children named on their own valid Health Care Card or residing in Care Services. Additionally, temporary or provisional visa holders, undocumented migrants and international students may also be eligible to apply.
