We acknowledge the Aboriginal people as the Traditional Owners of this land and we pay our respects to Elders past and present.

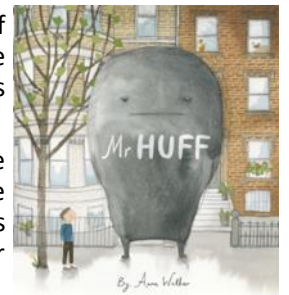
