

3/4 SCIENCE QUEST

In quest the 3/4 classes has been conducting some experiments, such as crystal growing and lava lamps.

To make the lava lamps we put water, oil and food colouring into a bottle before putting in a fizzing tablet like aspirin tablets to make the water make coloured bubbles flow up through the oil.

For the crystal experiment we had to break of the top of eggs and then clean out all the membrane on the inside, then we had to put in warm water and put in salt, rock salt, sugar, baking soda or borax and after a couple of weeks you'll have crystals in an egg.
