Looking forward to seeing everyone at our Movie Night tonight!



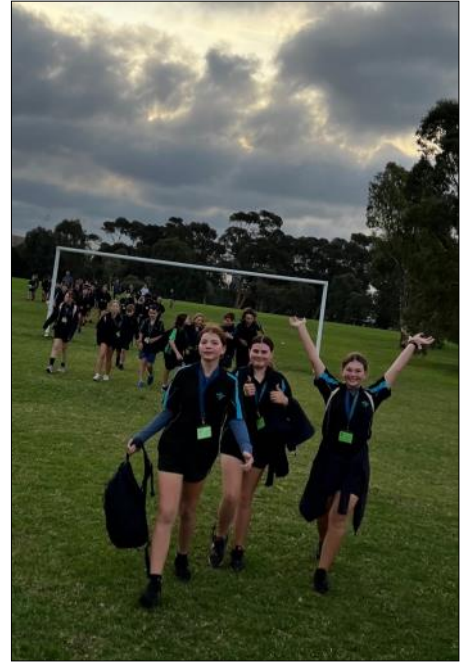
