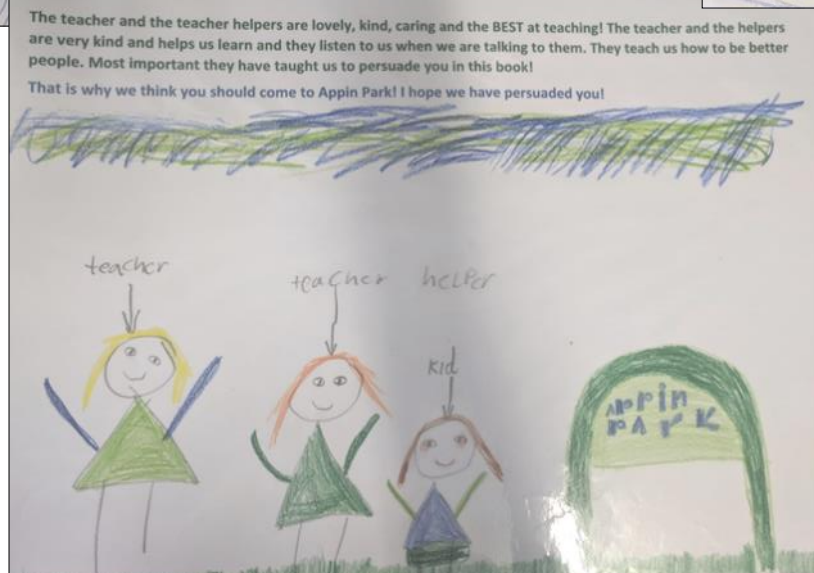
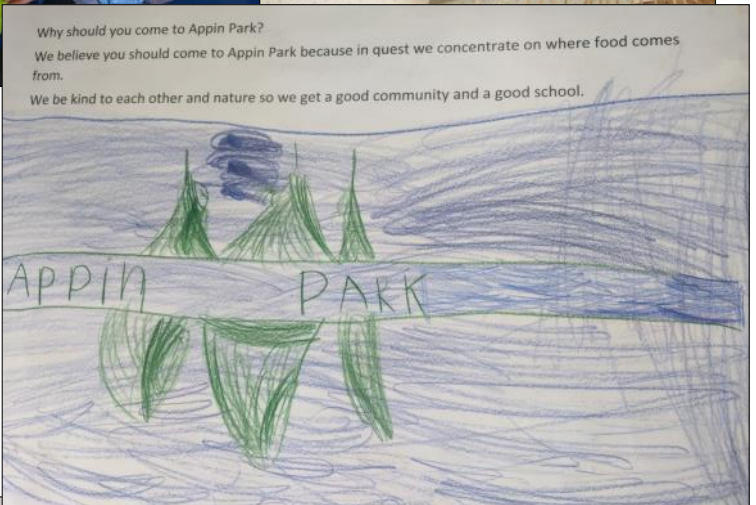
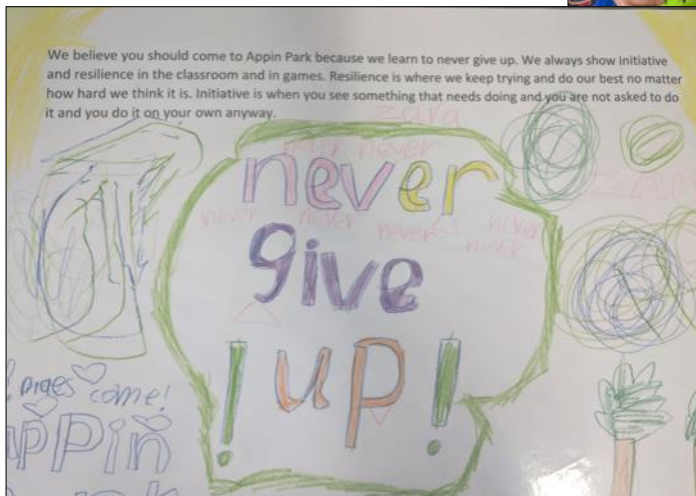
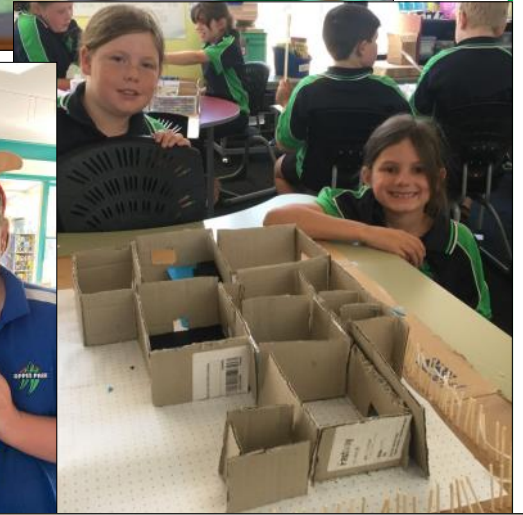
## END OF YEAR CHANGES

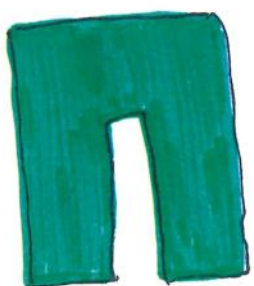
