Hello Everyone

Welcome to term 4. It's hard to believe we are in the final term of the year and although the return back is a little confusing, we are hoping that by Tuesday 26th October we will all be back together.

Return to school - Week 2 & 3 (Mon 11th Oct – Mon 25th Oct):

- F-2 continue to attend every day
- Yr 3/4s attend Tuesday and Wednesday
- Yr 5/6s attend Thursday and Friday

Week 4 (from Tuesday 26th Oct): All students, all year levels return onsite.

These decisions have been made with the intent to:

- 1) minimise the number of total students onsite; and
- 2) reduce cohort mixing should there be a positive case.

The request for supervision form is available for next week via the link on Compass and our Facebook page.

Andrew Storer will be on leave from next week for 3 weeks. Robyn Dykes will be looking after 3/4s and providing supervision for onsite students. Craig Kerlin will run WebEx meetings for all 3/4 students and prepare the learning packs. He will also be available to contact via Dojo.

Remote Learning Packs 3-6

Learning Packs for *grade 5/6 students* will be available for collection tomorrow (Friday) from 1:30. These will have learning tasks for Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of next week.

Learning for *3/4 students* will be shared via Dojo and a Webex meeting on Monday morning and a Learning Pack will be sent home with students on Wednesday afternoon for at home learning Thursday, Friday and Monday.

Until we have further advice the following covid safe measures are still in place:

- Please wear your mask if coming on school grounds;
- Students are to be dropped off and collected via the drive through or front and back gates;
- We ask that parents and carers do not come onsite at this stage unless absolutely necessary and that the QR code is used to check in;
- Avoid congregating at the gates where possible.

In other news we have had to postpone our school swimming program until further notice. We are hopeful that we may be able to get some sessions in during November, but again will need to wait for further easing of restrictions before doing so.

Disappointingly we have had to cancel our production for 2021, again due to restrictions and audience capacity limits at the Wang PAC. We know this is disappointing for our students many of whom have worked very hard at preparing but it is not something we have any control over.

Now that we are into term 4, please check that your child comes to school with their broad brimmed hat as per our Sun Smart policy. Caps and visors are not considered a suitable alternative.

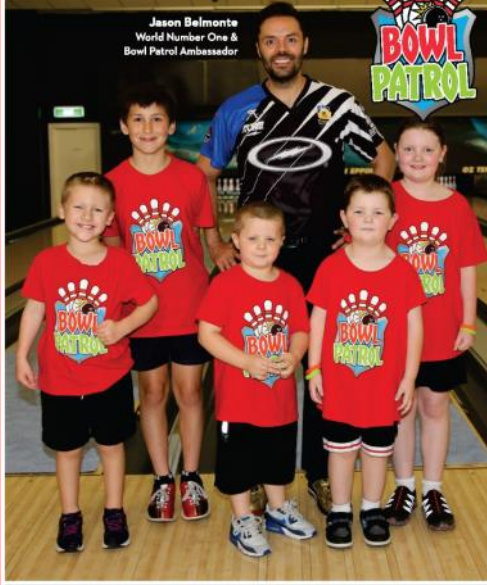

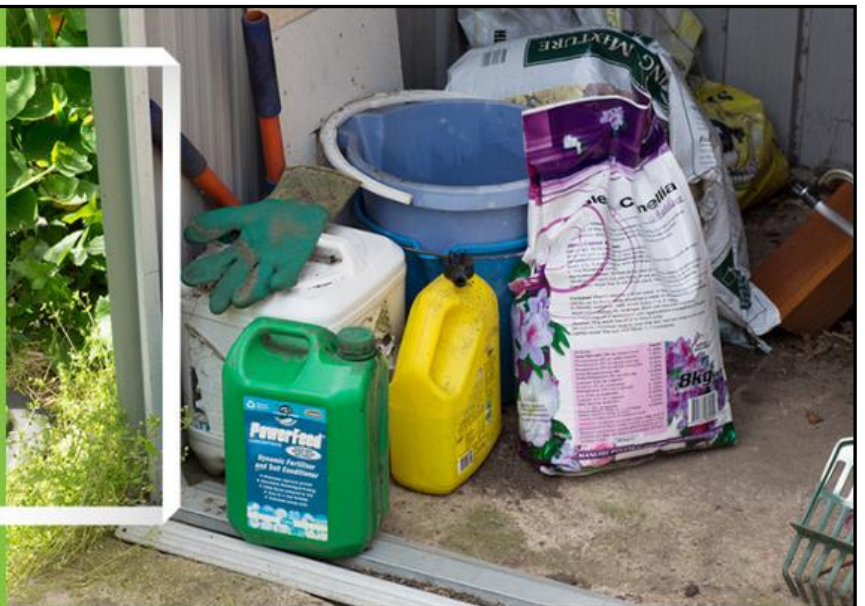
