### Resilience, Rights and Respectful Relationships at Appin Park Primary School

Resilience, Rights and Respectful Relationships is an initiative to support schools and early childhood education settings to promote and model respect and equality. It also supports educators to teach our children how to build healthy relationships, resilience and confidence. At Appin Park Primary School, Respectful Relationship sessions are undertaken weekly in all classrooms F-6. The materials cover eight social and emotional learning topics to support the delivery of respectful relationships content through the Victorian Curriculum. The Victorian Curriculum F-10 includes learning about respectful relationships in both health and physical education and personal and social capability. The resources support a whole of school approach to creating equal and respectful attitudes, behaviours, structures and practices across the school culture and ethos. The learning materials cover eight topics of Social and Emotional Learning across all levels of primary and secondary education: *Emotional Literacy; Personal Strengths; Positive Coping; Problem Solving; Stress Management; Help Seeking; Gender and Identity; and Positive Gender Relationships.*


### 2023 Foundation Students – Open Morning Tuesday March 29<sup>th</sup>, 9:30-10:30

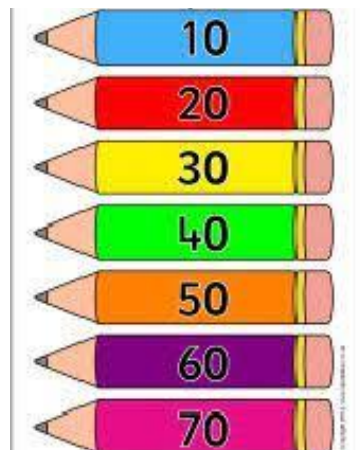
