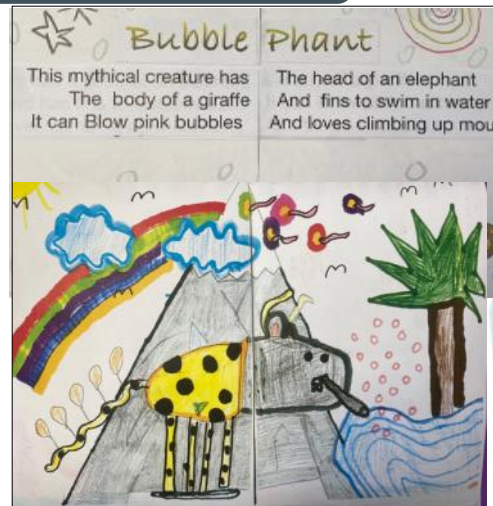
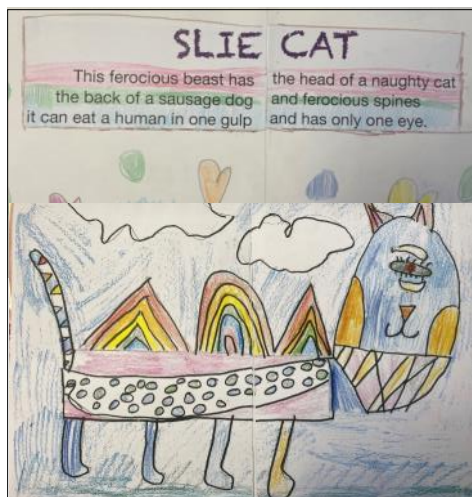
The loudest thing in the world is a lion
